Squash Tournament Rules

Closing date for entries: **Monday 1 December 2008** (Definitely no extensions)

1. Players may enter only **one** event and must be under the required age on **21 December 2008**.
2. Players must wear eye protection. This can be purchased from the Tournament desk.
3. Players must be England Squash Junior Members for the current season unless they do not play outside their county or are overseas players (does not apply to Mixed Under 11s). For England Squash Junior Membership enquiries, call: 0161 231 4499 .
4. There will be a Tournament T-shirt for every player and prizes for winners and runners-up (please state preferred T-shirt size on the Entry Form above).
5. All players must enter a Plate event if they lose their first match in the first or second round. Withdrawal from the Plate without a medical certificate will be registered as a result on the ranking computer.
6. **All players (apart from Under 11s) must be available to play at any time on Friday 19 December.**
7. Players must be available to mark if requested.
8. From 15 December players will be able to find out match times & the draws & direction to the Club from the Club's website before the start of the tournament – www.stghltc.co.uk
9. In the event of a large entry the Tournament Director reserves the right to limit the size of the draw in any event to 32 players.
10. First matches on Friday 19 December will start at 9:30am. Where possible, a later starting time will be allocated where a long journey is involved. Last matches on Saturday may start as late as 7:30pm.
11. Players must report to the Tournament Desk at least 10 minutes before the start of each match.
12. Due to court pressure it may be necessary to play the early rounds of the plate on outside courts. All plate semi-finals and finals will take place at the Club.
13. All finalists are expected to attend the Presentation, which will take place immediately after the Final.
14. All matches will be played under the England Squash Rules and Codes of Conduct. Players shall wear clothing suitable for squash. Current England Squash Disciplinary Procedures will be enforced. Withdrawal from the Tournament must be notified to the Organisers as soon as possible by telephone with a valid reason, which should then be confirmed in writing to the England Squash within 7 days, and in the event of illness or injury, should be accompanied by a letter of explanation or medical certificate.
15. Parents are asked not to interfere in matches, but to address any complaints to the Tournament Desk.
16. Results from this Sanctioned Event will be forwarded immediately to the England Squash for ranking and seeding purposes.
17. The Tournament Organiser and St George's Hill LTC do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage, or injury to competitors or those accompanying them.
18. The Tournament Organiser's decision on all matters is final.
